Female magicians are extremely rare, even in 2018. However, many talented ladies have come to light recently and taken the world of magic by storm, and Carisa Hendrix is one of those ladies. When Hendrix's lovable magic character Lucy Darling hits the stage, audiences fall in love. This unique and charming act has kept her touring North America over the past year, performing in New York, at the Chicago Magic Lounge, and the world-famous Magic Castle in Hollywood.

You can see Carisa Hendrix at the **Melbourne Magic Festival** in **LUCY DARLING, THAT TINGLING SENSATION**, running from July 3–7 at the Melba Spiegeltent, 35 Johnston Street, Collingwood. This semi-improvised, queer-positive comedy magic show takes audiences on an adventure into the world of sassy, surreal socialite Lucy Darling. It's **Zsa Zsa Gabor and Mae West** meets *Dream of Jeannie*. The show is a little bit bawdy, positively hilarious, and truly amazing. Lucy's show in 2017 earned her the Melbourne International Comedy Festival Award for "Best Comedy Magic Show" at the Melbourne Magic Festival.

Hendrix is a magician and actress featured in the **Guinness Book of World Records** (2014 Book, Page 86), **Ripley's Believe it or Not** (2015 Book), and is best known for the **Super Channel** documentary **Carisa Hendrix: Girl on Fire** released in October of 2016, which followed her to Las Vegas, where she opened her all-girl Magic and Illusion show.
